#### FUTURE HOME 62 S. GROVE AVE.



We continue to fundraise for the buildout and program development of our 62 BOUND campaign, supporting the future home at 62 S. Grove Ave. in downtown Elgin! With newly added support from local, state, and federal agencies, we aim to begin demolition and construction by summer 2025.

This adaptive reuse project will transform a historic 15,000 sq. ft., three-story property into a thriving arts and culture hub, significantly expanding our capacity to serve the community through:

- Doubling free arts programming, ensuring greater accessibility for all
- Creating new jobs in the arts, education, and event industries
- Hosting 10+ additional visual art exhibitions each year
- Introducing a robust lineup of large-scale performances, concerts, multidisciplinary arts events, and SO MUCH MORF!




